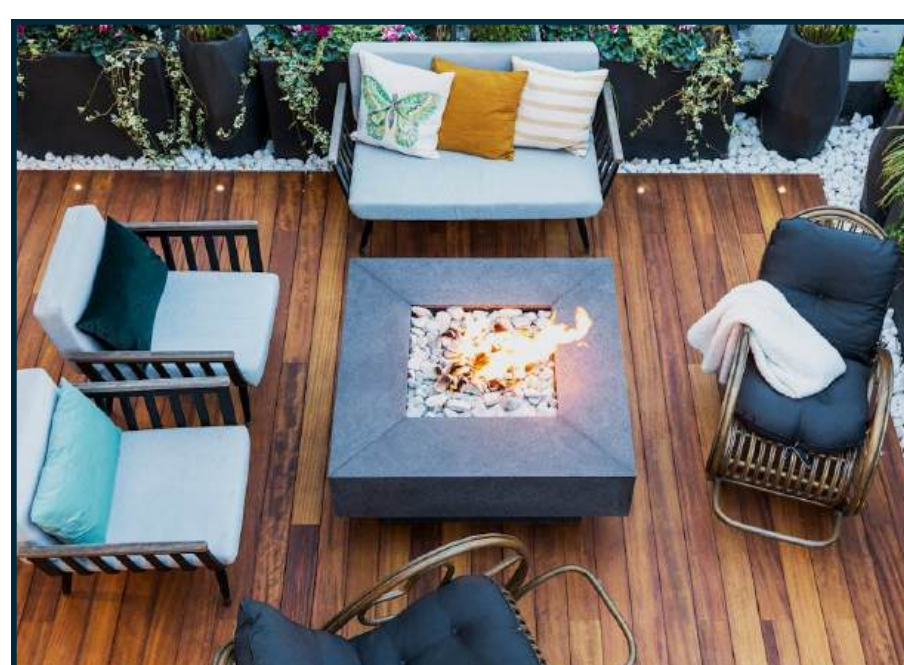


2. Wind, Sun, and Orientation Change Your Experience

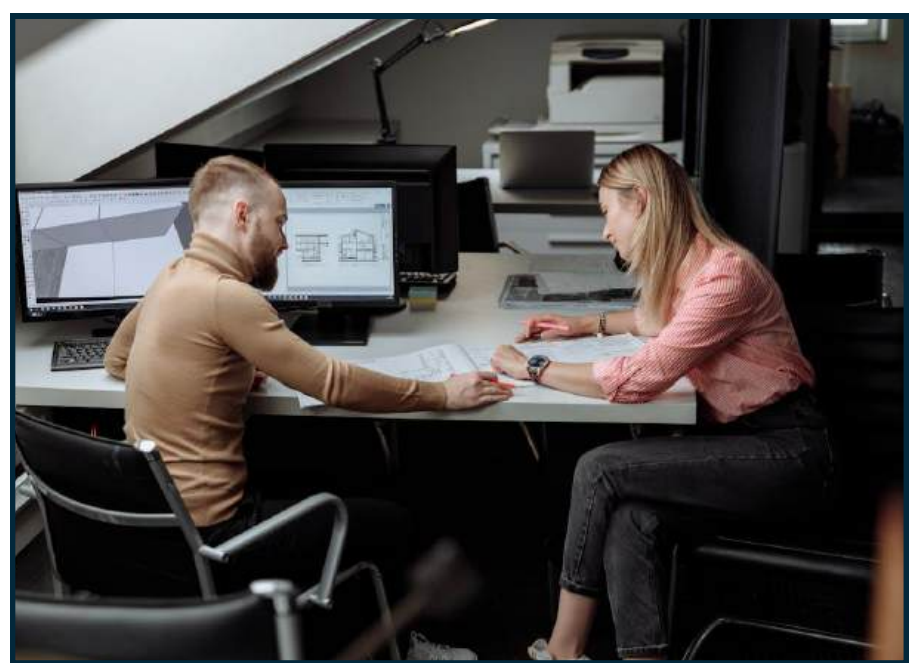


4. Placement Sets the Style and the Sightlines
